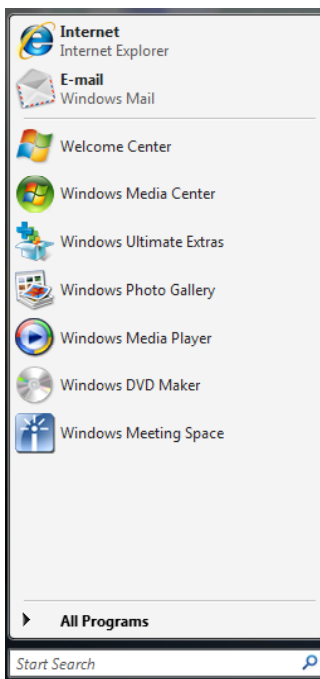
Wireless Registration Process – Windows Vista

(Note: Before you can complete this process, you must first register your computer through the wired connection in the residence halls.)

In order to use the wireless connection in the residence halls, you must register your wireless card through your personal GUS menu. This can be done entirely from your room. The following steps will register your wireless card for use in the residence halls.

Things you will need for registration: Your PSU ID Number, GUSPin, Previous registration through your wired connection, Ethernet cable (Cat5 or Cat5e).

1. Click the Windows logo in the lower left hand corner. A menu will pop up, with a search bar at the bottom.



2. In the search bar, type in the following: CMD.
3. At the top of the menu, a program called CMD should show up. Right-click this program and select, "Run as Administrator". A black box should appear on your screen at this point.

4. At this point, a window like the one below will appear. Type `ipconfig /all` and press enter.
5. The information seen below should appear. What you are looking for is “Wireless Network Connection” (2) and the “Physical Address” (3) beneath that header.
6. Write down the Physical Address, you will need it for the next step. (Make sure that you write the physical address for the Wireless connection, and not the wired.)

7. Open a web browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Netscape, etc.)
8. Login to your GUS account. This is where you will need your GUSPin and ID number. Your GUS account can be found at <http://go.pittstate.edu/gus>.
9. Once you login to your account, there will be a link to your left that says, ResNet Menu. Click this link.
10. There will be a link that says, “Register Wireless Access”. Click this link.
11. On this page, there will be a place to enter your wireless information. Type in the number. And that’s it! You are wireless in the halls!
